

Teen Driving Skills Testing

Before your teen driver can apply to take the driving skills test, he or she must have successfully completed Segment 2 of the driver education course, received the Segment 2 Certificate of Completion and logged a minimum of 50 hours supervised driving which includes a minimum of 10 hours at night.

It is highly recommended that parents review the Michigan Department of State's [Driving Skills Test Study Guide \(SOS-360\)](#) with their teens prior to scheduling a driving skills test. The driving skills test will consist of two parts - a basic control skills test and an on-road driving test.
